



## **PHAGO'SPRAY DASR 70**

No-rinse hydroalcoholic disinfectant for hands and surfaces.







- Food contact, no rinsing
- No trace or residue when drying

#### USE

PHAGO'SPRAY DASR 70 is a hydroalcoholic disinfectant for disinfecting hands, surfaces, equipment and clean furniture. It leaves no traces or residues on surfaces. It can be applied to a single-use wipe for rapid disinfection of small items of furniture, trolleys, external surfaces of non-invasive medical devices (operating table, operating lights, monitors, cables and connectors, stethoscopes, reflex hammers, blood pressure gauges) and small surfaces close to the patient.

PHAGO'SPRAY DASR 70 can be used, without rinsing, on surfaces that may come into direct contact with food (tables, work surfaces, trays, meal trolleys, slicers, choppers, knives, etc.).

#### **COMPOSITION**

Disinfecting agents:

Ethyl alcohol (N°CAS 64-17-5: 72% m/m).

Also contains: Water, isopropanol, tert-butanol, sorbic acid. 96% of the total ingredients are of natural origin.

#### **CHARACTERISTICS**

Appearance: Clear, colourless liquid Odour: alcohol pH (20°C): 4.0 - 7.0

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

PHAGO'SPRAY DASR 70 is ready to use.

Spray onto a single-use cloth and apply to the surface to be disinfected. Do not rinse.

Spray directly onto previously cleaned surfaces from a distance of 20 to 30 cm at a rate of 15 to 20  $\text{ml/m}^2$ .

Leave on for 2 minutes for a full spectrum of disinfection, or as required. Frequency of application: refer to the defined hygiene plan.

TP1 - Biocidal products for human hygiene.

TP2 - Disinfectant for surfaces, materials, equipment and furniture not in direct contact with food or animal feed.

TP4 - Disinfectant for surfaces in contact with foodstuffs.
